- > "Right to Control" Factor In these states, the individual who performs the work is free from control and direction over the performance of services
- > These states apply the Common-Law Test; follows Federal Guidelines, may have exceptions
- > These states apply the ABC Test to determine employee or independent contractor; some states limit the test to A and C
